Arboretum Community Association Homeowners Meeting Saturday, November 7, 2015 Arboretum Clubhouse - 10 AM

MINUTES

President Bob Hittinger (hereafter referred to as BobH) called the Arboretum Community Association Annual Homeowners Meeting to order at 10 a.m. Board members present: Bob Baginski (hereafter referred to as BobB), Jeanne Campbell, Bob Hittinger (hereafter referred to as BobH), and E Gifford Stack. Board members absent: Rob Clarke.

ROLL CALL - BobH requested a roll call of ACA lot owners. Present either in person or via proxy were 70 ACA lot owners.

MINUTES FROM 2014 ANNUAL MEETING - BobH asked for a motion to approve the minutes of the of the November 1, 2014, ACA Annual Homeowners Meeting. BobB so moved, E Gifford seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.

NOMINATING COMMITTEE REPORT - BobH asked attendees to cast their ballot from the three candidates running for the two available seats: Dan Donovan, Bob Hittinger, and Sharon Remaly. Jeanne and two members of her committee took the ballots away for counting.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT - BobH recognized the numerous volunteers who helped our homeowners association during the past 12 months. He extended special recognition and thanks to Pat Wells and Bob Ahlers for their extremely dedicated service over the years. A copy of BobH's remarks are attached. BobB expressed thanks on behalf of the community to BobH for his services as president again this year.

FINANCIAL REPORT - Tom Kehoe summarized the financial condition of the ACA as of October 31: Operating Fund balance of \$67,285 and the Capital Items Fund balance of \$94,099. Tom then reviewed the planned budget for 2016 which is estimated to be \$121,820 (\$87,120 for operating expenses and \$34,700 for capital items). He noted the one anomaly from the 2015 budget: the three-fold increase in street lighting electric charges. This is due to Brunswick Electric Membership Corporation updating our rate for the first time in many, many years, perhaps since the ACA started. Tom concluded by briefly reviewing the 2016 Long Range Capital Items plan. The Board accepted the Financial Report.

COMMITTEE UPDATES - BobH announced that Geoff Lubsen has agreed to replace Pat Well's (who is retiring) position on the Architectural Review Committee. Jim Plant will be the co-chair of the Building and Grounds Committee along with Jack Cowling. There will be several vacancies on the Pool and Spa Team in the coming months.

Anyone interested in serving on this committee should contact Rob Clarke or any Board member.

ELECTION RESULTS - BobB thanked Jeanne for chairing this year's nominating committee. He also thanked the three candidates who volunteered to serve on the 2016 Board, as well members of community who voted. The ACA members elected for a two-year term are Bob Hittinger and Sharon Remaly.

ADJOURN - At 11:42 a.m., E Gifford made a motion to adjourn. It was seconded by BobB and passed unanimously. BobH thanked the Social Committee for preparing lunch and asked everyone to enjoy!

<u>Security – John Wall ------</u> John is one of the most reliable persons I have ever worked with. He has put up with me for 11 years. Thanks John.


